

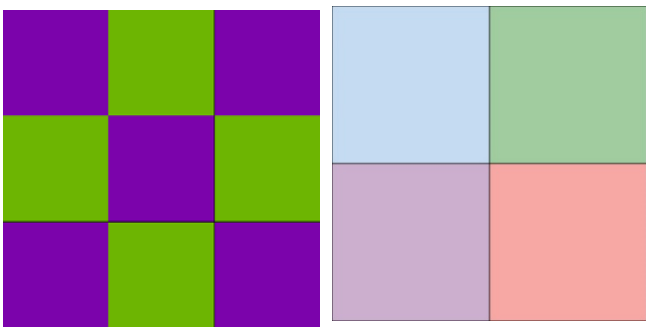
1. Quilting class – Basic Patchwork piecing.

This course starts with an introduction to the basic tools and how best to use them as well as two foundation blocks.

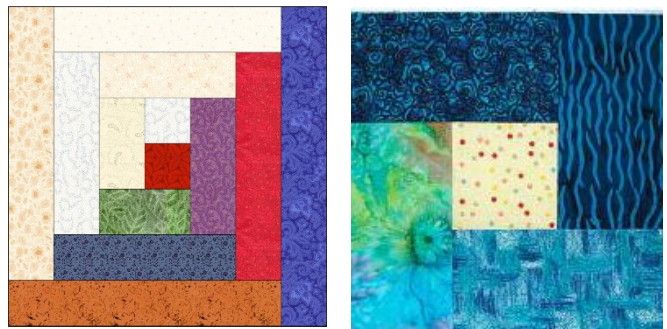
Each week, as the blocks increase in complexity, you will be shown how to work on the true grain, even with triangles, using time saving techniques.

Traditional styles will be covered for the first five weeks but then this course finishes with the contemporary, fun and fast 'Stack and Wack' technique.

Week 1 – Nine Patch Block & Four patch block



Week 4 -Rectangles and Strips – Log Cabin



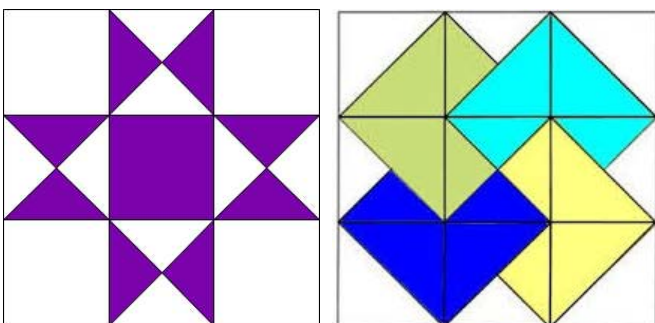
Week 2 -Single Triangles – Windmill and Puzzle blocks



Week 5 -Crazy Quilting



Week 3 -Double Triangles – Ohio Star & Card tricks



Week 6 – 'Stack and Wack' blocks



2.Fusing, Applique and Foundation piecing.

Fused quilts, Machine applique and Foundation piecing will be covered over six weeks. Fusing onto a gridded backing can be used to construct any traditional quilt style quickly and easily. Many contemporary fused quilts often utilize a raw edge applique technique as show in these patterns by Toni Whitney (available on e-bay).



Fused Applique can be applied over a traditional block or used as the main feature in the patterns above where the raw edged sections are finished with free motion quilt stitching. Blanket, blind hem stitch and satin stich can also be used to secure applique to the background for a more traditional result.



Paper piecing as shown in these free patterns from wombatquilts.com take all the stress out of quilting with triangles



3. Sewing Classes at The Village

Classes will be offered on Tuesdays at The Village in Triabunna.

Emphasis will focus on time saving techniques and low cost projects. The cost will be \$2 per session with a maximum of six people per session.

You only need to provide a basic sewing machine. Bring along your own quilting fabrics if you have them. Discounted fabrics and notions will be available for purchase and quilting tools will be provided for class use.
